A MESSAGE FROM THE CHANCELLOR OF TEMPORAL AFFAIRS

Many of you will soon receive a letter from Bishop De Angelis, regarding the diocesan debt. Having taken advice from the Diocesan Finance Committee and others, he is again appealing directly to all parishioners for assistance with the remaining debt. Please read his letter carefully and remember that the Lord Himself calls you to respond to this, as to all things, with faith, hope and love. A special collection for the diocesan debt will be taken on the weekend of July 18 and 19th, 2009. Envelopes for this purpose can be found in your envelope box and the entrance to the Church. The multi-million dollar debt is crippling this diocese, limiting what the bishop and his collaborators, the priest, can do. It has negative consequences for all of us, including this parish. The debt has been a problem for many years. In all Christian charity, please consider what help you can give in restoring the local Catholic Church to financial health.
