2009 DIOCESAN SEMINARIAN RETREAT



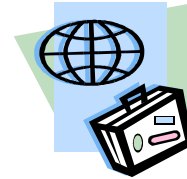

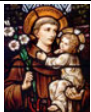
THE FIRST "R" RELATIONSHIPS
